

Toastmasters training in Brussels on August 26th 2018 - Creating effective communicators and leaders

The training day was organised by the Division B of District 59 which includes 22 Clubs located in different cities and areas around Belgium (see link).

This event, the Club Officers Training, was attended by 80+ participants from Belgium, the North of France and the Netherlands, members and non-members of Toastmasters, seeking to improve their public speaking and leadership abilities.

Toastmasters clubs in Belgium, most of which are bilingual are open to anyone. Their members are supported to learn the arts of speaking, listening and thinking — vital skills that promote self-actualisation, enhance leadership potential and foster human understanding.

Sunday's event included a keynote speech by Marie-Bernard Guillaume, Director at Mercuri Urval, who inspired participants to use their emotional intelligence and how each of us can develop it.
